The **1st Rule** of the library is:

DO SOMETHING ON THIS LIST!

(Hanging out is not on the list)



The **2nd Rule** of the library is:

RESPECT OTHERS!



READ! *(we have books)*

Sit on bean bag chairs, at tables, or in the Quiet Zones (see back) like the Fireplace area.



STUDY! *(get smart)*

Study rooms are available for individual or group study. You must have a library card or photo ID to use the study rooms. You may reserve a study room 24 hours or more in advance. If you have a large study group (6 or more students), you may ask to use the McKune room.



COMPUTERS!

(i can has cheezburger)

The Learning Lab is for individual use only, not for study groups. Groups may use the teen computers or the public computers. The library has many useful databases for students. For more information, go to

BOARD GAMES!

The library has a collection of games that you can play, just ask for a game at the Youth Information Desk.

Avoid the Quiet Zones when playing games.

Paper and art pencils are available at the Youth Information Desk.



VOLUNTEER!

(free cookies)

Join the Youth Service Group and help out at the library!

GOING OUTSIDE? *(bundle up!)*

The Rules still apply. Please do not climb on the walls of the parking lot or the reading garden. Avoid obstructing library entryways or sidewalks.



QUIET ZONES *(shhhhh!)*

Fireplace | Learning Lab | Study Rooms
McKune Room

ACTIVITY ZONES *(talking = ok)*

Teenspace | Public & Teen Computers
Study Tables | Youth Booths | Library Lawn

SNACKS *(om nom nom)*

Food and drink must be in snack size servings. Drinks must be in containers with screw-on caps, or coffee-style lids. Open drinks and snap-lids are not allowed.

CONSEQUENCES *(uh oh)*

If you are not actively engaged in an acceptable activity you will be added to the warning list.

WARNING LIST *(not good)*

The warning list is a record of your behavior at the library. If you are not engaging in an acceptable activity or act inappropriately (loud voice, roughhousing, talking back to a staff member) your name will be placed on the warning list. Continue the behavior, and you will be warned again.

If after two warnings you are spoken to again, or you do something **dangerous** or **destructive**, you will be ejected from the library, and your parents will be called. You will be allowed back in at the discretion of the library director.
